

Voter Checklist

Register to vote.

Don't know if you're registered to vote? Check at <https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/registration-check>. Call your County Clerk (<https://nj.gov/state/elections/county-eo.shtml>) if you have any questions or need to confirm the street address on your registration. Starting September 4th, you can also register to vote online in New Jersey. Visit <https://www.speakupnj.org/vote/> for details.

Figure out who you are voting for.

Take advantage of online resources, like BallotReady (<https://www.ballotready.org/>) or the state's Division of Elections Candidate Information page (<https://nj.gov/state/elections/candidate-information.shtml>), and candidates' websites and social media pages to learn more about each candidate and their policies.

Fill out your mail-in ballot.

All registered voters in New Jersey will automatically receive a mail-in ballot to the address they are registered at. The ballot will be mailed out of your county elections office by October 5th. Be sure to vote early to ensure your vote gets counted!

Drop off your ballot to a ballot box.

Each county has 10 ballot boxes - there is one at the Metuchen Borough Hall (500 Main Street, Metuchen). You can also put your ballot in the mail, but it must be postmarked no later than November 3rd, so vote early!

Vote in person if you need.

If you did not complete a mail in ballot, you can vote in person on November 3rd. Find your polling location at <https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/polling-place-search>. Remember, if you vote in person, you will not vote on the traditional voting machine, but will fill out a paper provisional ballot. Be sure to social distance and wear a mask!
